

TOURING LECTURER – AUGUST TO NOVEMBER 2015 WBro Dr MICHEL JACCARD, PhD (physics)

Every two years the ANZMRC brings an eminent Masonic researcher and author on a tour through Australia and New Zealand, hosted by the twenty-five affiliated Research Lodges, Chapters and Study Groups in both countries.

This year we bring WBro Michel Jaccard from Switzerland. WBro Jaccard is a 33° Freemason, a Past Master of Lodge Liberté #21 in Lausanne, a Past President of the Swiss Grand Lodge Alpina's Research Group (Groupe de Recherche Alpina – GRA) and the Editor-in-Chief of "Masonica", the quarterly publication of that group. As a retired university lecturer, WBro Jaccard is well versed in public speaking and, although French is his first language, he is fluent in English and other languages. The tour book, "Continental Freemasonry", contains each of the sixteen papers he has prepared for this tour. They deal with aspects of the Craft as practiced in Continental Europe, mainly in Switzerland, France and Germany.
